

Club President of the Year (2009-2010)

1. All District 36 Club Presidents for the 2009-2010 Toastmasters Year are eligible to apply for this award, except those who served as District Officers (of any District) during the year.
2. The President must submit the application only on his or her own behalf , and may submit only one application, even if he or she was President of two or more clubs during the year. A single club must be identified. All points credited (except for the President's own Educational Awards) must have been achieved through the one club.
3. Clubs electing officers semiannually (for six-month terms) may combine points achieved under both Presidential terms of office during the year; the award would go to both Presidents, jointly.
4. Applications are due to the 2009-2010 District Governor by **July 31, 2010**. The application must include the President's name, mailing address, and phone number.
5. All point claims must be supported with names, dates, places, and appropriate documentation (club agendas, etc.), when submitted for consideration. Educational awards will be verified through Toastmasters International and do not require additional documentation.
6. In addition to reporting points, the President must provide written answers to the two questions at the end of the application. Additionally, the President may wish to include statements or letters of recommendation from their Area and Division Governors. Such letters may be sent directly to the District Governor separately, but must be received by the **July 31** due-date.
7. The 2009-2010 District Governor will announce a winner in early August. The actual award will be presented to the winner at the Fall 2010 District Conference.
8. All decisions by the 2009-2010 District Governor are final.

Completed applications must be received by the District Governor by July 31, 2010.
