

Toastmaster of the Year (2009-2010)

1. All District 36 Toastmasters who are members in good standing of a club in good standing as of June 30, 2010, are eligible to apply for this award, except for District Officers (of any District) or Club Presidents in District 36.
2. Toastmasters must submit applications only on their own behalf. A Toastmaster may submit only one application; however, the points may be accumulated through any and all clubs in District 36 of which the Toastmaster was a member in good standing during the year.
3. Applications are due to the 2009-2010 District Governor by **July 31, 2010**. The application must include the Toastmaster's name, mailing address, and phone number. The Toastmaster must list all of the clubs of which he or she was a member during the year (including the time periods). The Toastmaster must identify one of those clubs as the "home club".
4. All educational awards included on the application must have been awarded through a club in District 36. Educational awards are: Competent Communicator, Advanced Communicator, Competent Leader, Advanced Leader, Leadership Excellence, Distinguished Toastmaster.
5. All activities presented for credit must have occurred within District 36, with the following exceptions: manual speeches; recruiting/sponsoring new members; Speechcraft; Youth Leadership; or service as a contest official (not participation as a contestant). Officers of clubs in District 36 may be credited for TLI training outside of District 36, if such training was recorded through District 36.
6. All point claims must be supported with names, dates, places, and appropriate documentation (club agendas, etc.), when submitted for consideration. Educational awards will be verified through Toastmasters International and do not require additional documentation.
7. The 2009-2010 District Governor will announce a winner in early August 2010 and submit the winner's name to Toastmasters International. The actual award will be presented to the winner at the Fall 2010 District Conference.
8. All decisions by the 2009-2010 District Governor are final.

Completed applications must be received by the District Governor by July 31, 2010.
